Registration information

The fee for each class is \$395 for tuition plus \$100 for group meals (required) (4 dinners & 5 breakfasts) for a total of \$495. There is a \$150 deposit required with registration to reserve your class space, and 50% of that is non-refundable (\$75). The balance, less deposit, is due Oct. 1. After Oct. 1, the full deposit (\$150) is non-refundable. In the event of weather-related school cancellation, the deposit may be applied to a rescheduled or future class of your choice. If a class is full or cancelled, you will be notified and may choose a different class, be put on a waiting list, or receive a full refund.

-There are limits of 8-10 students for all classes (first come/first serve).

-The group family-style dinners are currently scheduled for the Pony Island Restaurant; other restaurants may be added; breakfast will be at Deepwater Theater.

-Persons accompanying students, but not taking classes, may register for the group meals for the same price, \$100. Other extra activities will be charged on an individual first come/first serve basis depending on space.

-After registration, students will be sent a packet w/housing, map and ferry info, and materials lists/fees (not to exceed \$100) and any additional info for their class.

-Fee does not include housing; contact us if you need housing recommendations.

-Please contact us with handicap/special needs inquiries.
